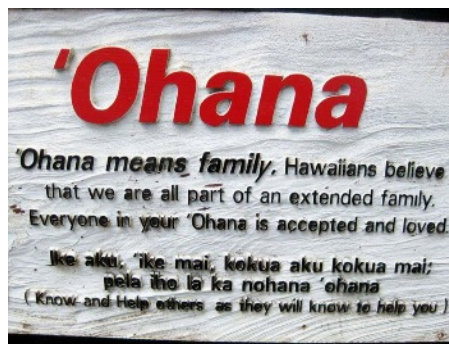




TOKA Benefit Seminar
